The UPTF is hiring a part-time member organizer for the fall semester. The successful candidate must be a full dues-paying member of the UPTF employed by WSU in the fall semester and be available to work for a total of 40 hours during the fall semester. The employment period will run from October 09 through November 22, an average of 4 to 6 hours weekly. Computer skills and the ability to talk face to face with fellow members are required.

The primary duty of the member organizer will be to meet with members of the bargaining unit one on one, discuss any issues or problems members may have, sign-up new Part-time Employees of Wayne State University as union members, and, in general, help to put a face to the union for our members.

The successful candidate will receive two hours of compensated training, and will then accompany an experienced member organizer during the next six (6) hours of employment. The UPTF pays \$20.00 per hour. However, the Employee will be expected to attend without compensation (i.e., as a volunteer) the monthly Union Council Meeting, the bi-weekly Organizing Committee meeting, and the Fall General Membership Meeting.

If this program is successful, the UPTF may renew the member organizer for a similar number of hours during the winter semester.
